I often find myself walking around the house singing or humming a tune. There are even times in the hallways of the building you will hear me humming or whistling a chorus or hymn that came to mind.

In today's Scripture David writes, "I will sing of your strength, in the morning I will sing of your love; for you are my fortress, my refuge in times of trouble."



David made such a good life choice here. Somewhere in his growing-up years, perhaps when he was just a shepherd boy watching sheep, he decided to begin his day with God. No matter what was going on in his life, he took time to reflect on the strength, love, goodness, and protection of

the Lord. The prologue to this very psalm reveals that David continued this practice—even though men outside his front door were waiting to kill him!

The Bible makes the point that there's something special about seeking God in the morning, especially in times of trouble. When you begin the day singing about His strength, you'll be less likely to "sing the blues" when the day is over.


