

- the Canada and Bermuda Territory has personnel serving at International Headquarters and in eight other territories and commands: Australia; Caribbean; Germany, Lithuania and Poland; Italy and Greece; Papua New Guinea and Solomon Islands; USA Western; Zimbabwe; and Zambia.
- The Salvation Army is present in more than 400 communities across Canada and in 133 countries around the world.
- The Salvation Army's International Development Department has been involved in emergency and development projects for over sixty years.
- last year, more than 6,000 children were helped internationally with school fees, housing, meals and spiritual support through our Brighter Futures Children's Sponsorship Program.
- our main priorities for international development work are: mother and child health; food security/agriculture; income generation/livelihood development; education and care of children; and disaster relief.
