#### **Responsive Scripture:**

**Leader:** As we think about being saved from our sins, it might be helpful to first define sin. In both the Old and New Testaments, the words most commonly translated as sin—in Hebrew, *hata*, and in Greek, *hamartia*—mean to stray from the path or to miss the mark. This implies that there is a right path, a mark, or an ideal that we're meant to follow as human beings.

**All:** The path we're meant to live, the ideal we were created to pursue, is laid out through scripture. It includes practicing justice, demonstrating loving kindness, and walking humbly with God. Micah 6:8

**Leader:** It includes sharing your food with the hungry, clothing the naked, and having compassion for the sick, the stranger, and the prisoner. Matthew 25:35-45; Isaiah 58:6-10

All: It is captured in the Ten Commandments, Jesus summarized the path with two commandments Moses had been given: Love God with your entire being, and love your neighbor as you love yourself. The latter he summarized again with the Golden Rule: "In everything do to others as you would have them do to you" Matthew 7:12 (NRSV). Do you always walk this path?

**Leader:** As humans we all struggle with sin. Christianity asserts that sin is the fundamental problem in the human condition. In the New Testament, sin is used to describe both the inner predisposition or inclination to stray from God's path or our nature and the actual act of straying which is our actions. The result is suffering, alienation, guilt, and shame. Paul captured this battle in Romans 7:18-19 (NIRV) when he wrote:

**All:** <sup>18</sup> I know there is nothing good in my desires controlled by sin. I want to do what is good, but I can't. <sup>19</sup> I don't do the good things I want to do. I keep on doing the evil things I don't want to do.

**Leader:** He later continues:

**All:** <sup>21</sup> Here is the law I find working in me. When I want to do good, evil is right there with me. <sup>22</sup> Deep inside me I find joy in God's law. <sup>23</sup> But I see another law working in me. It fights against the law of my mind. It makes me a prisoner of the law of sin. That law controls me. <sup>24</sup> What a terrible failure I am! Who will save me from this sin that brings death to my body? <sup>25</sup> I give thanks to God who saves me. He saves me through Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 7:21-25 (NIRV)

**Leader:** Who is it that delivers him or saves him? "Jesus Christ our Lord!" Jesus is our Savior, Deliverer, Helper, and Healer.
